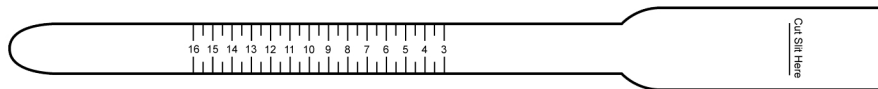




Measure the line on the left to ensure it is exactly 2 inches.  
If the measurement isn't accurate, please review your print settings again

### Method 1 - Paper Sizer

- Carefully cut out the paper sizer below. Be sure to make a small slit in the end for the ruler to slide through.
- Wrap the sizer around your finger with the numbers facing out and slide the rounded end through the slit.
- For an accurate measurement, pull the sizer tight over the widest part of your finger. This could be a knuckle.
- Read the number that lines up next to the slit. This is your ring size.



*Tips for accurate measurement*

- \* Measure your finger later in the day when it is at its largest
- \* Avoid measuring your finger when its cold, which are at their smallest.

### Method 2 - Measure an Existing Ring

- Choose a ring that fits the desired finger.
- Place the ring over the circles below. Match the inside edge of the ring with the closest circle. This is the inside diameter of the ring.
- If the ring falls between two sizes, select the larger of the two.
